LIMERICK LANE bumped with outside rival at the start, settled off the pace, advanced between foes, continued two wide then along the rail, reached the front exiting the turn, quickly cleared then just lasted from along the fence. AURELIA D void of early foot, angled over trailing the pace, made steady progress inside around the turn and in upper stretch, shifted out a sixteenth out then closed strongly, drifted out bit under left hand urging and narrowly missed. LA INDIA ELEGANT bumped at the break, chased on three wide path into and around the turn, rallied from between horses and bested others. HARD STORM broke inward and bumped foe, stalked from the outside, remained four wide around the bend, came out further in the lane and went willingly to the wire. CHOCOLATE CALIENTE was bumped from both sides leaving the gate, dueled then forced the pace from outside rival, lugged out around the turn and weakened in the drive. NO APOLOGY stumped and was bumped at the start, recovered and dueled from the inside, drifted out bit then gave way in the stretch. THINKING OF YOU stalked from along the rail, was inside winner leaving the backstretch, remained inside and weakened.
