SPANKSTER was off step slow, moved up to force pace, bid between rivals on the turn, hooked up in stretch-long battle outside foe and gamely prevailed under strong right hand urging. RITZVILLE was sent up inside to grab early lead, set pace into the turn, resisted inside when challenged, battled inside winner and lost narrow decision. ARGYLL LAD showed early foot then settled off the leaders, tracked pace from the outside, loomed three wide on the turn but yielded in the drive. NUCLEAR MISSILE angled over early, chased from the inside and found his best stride late. WARREN'S BANDIT saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside into the stretch and lacked any rally. WHOLELOTACONGRATS stumbled to his nose leaving the gate, reserved from well off the rail and outside foe, remained bit wide and was outrun.
