Footnotes

EL GATO GUAPO stalked leaders early from off the rail, moved up three wide, engaged leaders in upper stretch, battled and inched away under urging. FIRSTSATURDAYINMAY came off the rail, rushed up to grab brief lead, battled between horses into and through the lane then held for share of second. DINNER AT JAKE'S was washy going to the gate, reserved off the pace, chased three wide around the turn, rallied outside and was up to finish on even terms for the place. SWISS ALPINE quickly sped to the front then forced the pace inside, battled along the rail under strong handling but yielded ground late. ECHO WEST was forwardly placed early, angled in some, chased two wide into and through the lane and went willingly to the wire. T. W. 'S TANK unhurried early, chased three wide, shifted out some in upper stretch and surged late from the outside to earn share of minor award. JUST CHARMED was off alertly then settled off the place, chased outside, continued four wide and lacked any late rally. DOWNTOWN KING chased from the inside, came off the rail, between foes into the lane and was no factor. SUCCESSFUL KNIGHT settled off the leader, shifted over, chased two wide on the turn and was no late threat. FUN'S TOP HIT bobbled leaving the gate and almost unseated its rider, dropped back then was not persevered with in the stretch.
