BACK NINE DOC settled off the pace, made steady progress four then three wide into the stretch then rolled past the pacesetter under right hand urging. DANCING JEANNIE set pressured pace from the inside, edged away in upper stretch but could not hold off the winner. CARAT FOR C. C. prominently placed early, chased either two wide or outside foe, drifted out some exiting the turn, rallied from the outside and gained third. LOVE TO FISH KONA forced the pace into the turn, remained on two wide path, dropped back in upper stretch then weakened late and lost placing. HARD EIGHT chased from off the rail, was briefly inside winner on the backstretch and lacked needed late punch. MAGGIE'S PATCHES stalked leaders from the inside, saved ground into the lane and also lacked late response. RAINBOW WEAVER was off slow, trailed while slightly off the fence, remained on two wide path and never menaced. MY POPCORN hugged the rail into the stretch and was outrun throughout.
