Footnotes

SWISS ALPINE flashed keen early foot, set uncontested pace from the inside, retained clear cushion into the stretch and safely held under steady handling. OUR JUKE BOX HERO shifted over early, tracked pace from the inside then along the rail, roused in upper stretch and whittled gap on winner late. LOCKSMITH was forwardly placed, chased while outside rival, continued three then four wide to the stretch and finished strongly from the outside. TECHNICIAN was closest pursuer from the inside, continued to track pacesetter while two wide and weakened from between rivals nearing the wire. MEDIA MAKER was bit reluctant to load, reserved off the pace, raced on two then three wide path and went willingly to the wire. SOUTHERN VICTORY was void of early foot while well off the fence, chased three wide to the bend then four wide around the turn and only passed tiring foes. GOOCHIO stalked inside rival and well off the rail, continued three wide, drifted out further exiting the turn and weakened. WARREN'S PRANCER took awkward step leaving the gate, reserved inside, saved ground and failed to threaten. BOYO lagged back early, saved ground but was outrun throughout.
