Footnotes

TOY'S TOY prompted the early issue from the outside, moved up, bid three wide on turn, came three deep into the lane, reached the front and kicked clear under urging. CARD'S GOLD bumped at the start, forced the pace, challenged between horses into the lane, could not match the winner late but was clearly next best. PAT OLCOTT was sent to the front, collared on the turn, battled briefly inside then weakened. LAST CHANCE BOBBY settled well off the rail, chased four wide around the turn and into the lane and was no threat. TALENTED COPY broke out and bumped foe, unhurried from the inside, saved ground but was never a factor. MIG ALLEY was off slow, chased inside, came off the fence but never reached contention. R. D.'S ANGEL lagged back early, later angled to the rail, remained inside but was outrun.
