FORD ISLAND was hard asked early, stalked the leaders to the turn, moved up and bid three deep on the bend, reached the front exiting the turn and determinedly held outside runner-up. AFTER REALITY contested the early issue from the inside, held brief lead on the turn, relinquished command into the lane, battled inside winner and lasted for the place. ATLANTRA'S TANTRUM unhurried while shifting over, saved ground chasing the leaders, swung back out three wide, came out further in the drive and closed strongly late from the outside. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE broke inward, reserved from the inside, raced along the rail throughout and never threatened. SELF DEFENSE settled outside, chased outside rival and five wide into and around the turn while lacking needed response. RAPALLO dueled outside foe then between horses on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened. SHEVAL DOM SALLAY chased from off the fence then four wide into the turn, continued wide and was outrun.
