### Footnotes

PLAYING FOR KEEPS was quickly hustled to the front, set uncontested pace from the inside, drifted out bit exiting the turn and nearing the wire but clearly prevailed under steady handling. GIUSEPPE G reserved from off the rail, shifted in on the turn, rallied inside through the stretch and pulled away from rival to prove second best. GRATIS stalked pacesetter from the inside, also drifted out entering the stretch, came out further through the lane and held for third. WARRENS TWO TO ONE was void of early foot, trailed from the inside, continued along the rail into and through the stretch and passed tiring rivals. RICKY EL CORREDOR stalked early from the outside, caught three deep into the bend, came four wide into the stretch and was no threat. A TRUE RUMOR between horses early, dropped back around the turn and weakened.
