### Footnotes

WARREN'S HOT STUFF contested the early pace from the inside, established slim lead on the turn, came out bit exiting the turn, continued off the rail and powered away under urging. FULL ON was off a step slow, settled inside, came off the rail, continued two wide into the stretch and rallied to get up late for second. GET OFF THE SUGAR dueled three abreast early, stalked the pace from off the rail and outside foe, was fanned five wide into the lane and then was nailed on the wire for second. SEAFIRE needed an equipment repair in the gate, settled off the pace, chased inside, remained along the rail and never threatened. NATIONWIDE FAMILY stalked from off the rail then four wide on the turn and into the stretch, angled in some and was no threat. THUNDER ONE dueled from between horses early, lost contact on the turn, lugged out four wide into the lane and gave way.
