GREENWICH PARK (SAF) quickly sprinted well clear, set uncontested pace from the inside, padded cushion in the lane and crushed while ridden out. KENTER CANYON was forced out bit at the start, stalked four deep into the turn, came in but while closest pursuer around the turn and lasted for second from between foes. WARREN'S HOT STUFF broke out some, between horses and three abreast to the turn, drifted out bit, came three wide into the lane and rallied late to gain minor award. BOBBY THE FAT BOY tracked the pacesetter from the inside, remained along the rail throughout and was outfinished for better placing. WETASKIWIN reserved early, chased four wide to the bend, was forced five wide around the turn and into the lane while outrun. SKATTLE SEATTLE was crowded at the start, dropped far back early, came in and never threatened. FOREIGN TAUREAN between horses and two wide early, was squeezed and shuffled back leaving the backstretch, came out and never recovered. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the incident into the far turn and did not make a change.
