### Footnotes

PREPPY PILOT dueled outside rival early, gained lead into the bend, shook free around the turn and stretched cushion under moderate hand pressure. ONE OF A KIND unhurried while shifting over early, advanced around the turn, came out bit, split horses and was up for the place. POLKATIME BAND briefly forced the pace from the outside, stalked leaders on three wide path, remained on same path late and was outfinished for second. LAS VEGAS LUCKY dueled then forced the pace from the inside, lost contact on the turn and weakened from along the rail. ALIE'S DIN DIN unhurried early, angled over, saved ground thereafter but was never a factor. BALANCE THE SCORE was bit restless prior, but stood still for the start, however he tossed his head simultaneously when the gate opened while the rider lost his balance and nearly fell off, dropped far back early, was eventually eased in the stretch and walked off.
