### Footnotes

FAST TRACKING dueled from the outside into and around the bend, then proved best by clearing UNCLE GLEN in the stretch for the victory. UNCLE GLEN dueled from the inside into the lane, then proved no match late but was able to hold the place. YOUONLYLIVEONCE settled in the early stages, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished well. STRONG SUGGESTION traveled near the back f the field, was located in the two path on the turn, then showed mild rally in the drive. POPPY PEAK showed no early speed, raced three to four wide entering the stretch and displayed a mild response to urging. GRAND TOPPER broke well, couldn't match strides with the two leaders and chased rivals into the turn, went two wide around the bend, then failed to rally in the stretch. DESTINY KNOCKS raced mid-pack down the backstretch, saved ground along the rail and faded.
