PLANET JANET broke out but quickly recovered and briefly dueled outside foe, gained lead, padded cushion into the lane then stretched that margin under strong right hand urging. COURAGE N GRACE forced the early issue then tracked pacesetter from the inside, came three wide into the stretch and gamely held the runner-up spot. LA INDIA ELEGANT reserved from the inside, saved ground throughout and finished strongly inside runner-up. TO THE TOP stalked early from the outside, moved up three wide, loomed on the turn, came four wide into the lane but weakened bit in the drive. DANCING KITTY close up early from the inside, came out on the turn then was four wide leaving the bend, remained outside and lacked needed late punch. AURELIA D was widest of all chasing to the turn, shifted over, found the fence on the turn, remained inside and lacked any late response. JUANA GALLOS hopped leaving the gate, settled between horses, continued two wide then outside rival and never menaced.
