COPY THAT DREAM stalked pacesetter from the outside early, advanced and bid approaching the stretch, gained command and powered away under urging. SMOKIN MOJO bumped at the start, unhurried while shifting out early, caught five wide leaving the turn, rallied off the rail and was along for second. IRON WORKER GEORGE forwardly placed early while angling over, stalked outside foe then three wide, remained on same path late and was along for third. NEIGHPOM bumped at the break, shifted over while showing good early foot, tracked pacesetter from the inside, remained two wide but lost placing late. FREE BET sped to the front, set pace into the turn, was overtaken entering the stretch and weakened from between horses. KEITH THE MAILMAN settled off the pace, chased from the inside throughout and lacked an effective late punch. ZOILO unhurried from the inside, hugged the rail into and around the turn and failed to menace. ETHIOPIAN settled off the rail, chased three wide most of the route before altering course off heels nearing the wire. DENMAN reserved while shifted well off the fence, chased five wide to the turn, remained very wide and was outrun.
