Footnotes

SEAFIRE had good early foot then settled off the leaders, stalked from the inside, angled three wide entering the lane, roused and collared leader passing sixteenth marker before edging away under urging. ALPINE NUGGET was hard asked leaving the chute, pressured the leader from the inside, gained slim lead leaving the turn, edged away but relinquished control a sixteenth out and held second. BEV'S EX taken off the rail early, chased two wide around the turn, regained the fence in the drive, loomed in mid stretch and held gamely for third. GAME OF LUCK reserved from the outside, moved up three wide and outside winner, came four wide and outside same foe into the stretch and lacked needed late response. UNIQUE EFFORT bit off the rail early, in tight passing five-sixteenths marker, later swung out exiting the turn, remained on far outside and improved placing. WARRENS FLYIN HIGH chased from the inside, remained along the rail entering the lane and was no threat. KALOOKAN HEAT set pressured pace while outside runner-up, relinquished command leaving the turn and gave way readily from between horses. FOR CONTRAST unhurried while well off the rail, chased three wide around the turn and was outrun.
