WARREN'S HOT STUFF settled outside, raced three deep early, made steady progress on same path into the stretch, closed under right hand urging and nailed leader on the wire. ARROGANT CARSON sprinted to clear lead while crossing over, set uncontested pace from the inside into the stretch but could not stave off winner. DAILY SUDS was hard asked early, chased while slightly off the rail then three wide around the turn, came out further in the lane and cleared for the show. EL GRAN BULL was off bit awkward and slow, chased from the inside, angled out some, came three wide into the stretch and improved placing. SWEET SENOR stalked from between foes and inside winner early, continued on same two wide path, drifted out slightly departing the turn and weakened. PORFIRIO S B tracked the pacesetter from the inside, remained along the rail throughout and lacked needed rally. DOWNTOWN KING was unhurried from off the rail, chased four then three wide and was outrun. HECCOULDGOALLTHEWAY dropped well back in the early going, trailed from well off the rail and was outrun throughout.
