Footnotes

MISS TRIPLE PLAY reserved early then was steered to the inside, found the fence, rallied along the rail through the stretch and collared leader late under strong handling. SI MAR'S DEAR dueled early from along the rail then gained slim advantage inside on the turn, came out slightly exiting the bend, dug in gamely in the drive but could not hold the winner. TABLE FOR ONE forced the pace from between horses, remained on two wide path on the turn, also came bit slightly in the stretch and inched away late to best others. JOYFUL CREATOR pressured the pace from between foes, remained three then four wide into the stretch, continued on same path and gave ground grudgingly. HEAVENLY BEING battled prominently from the outside, remained four wide into the bend, came out further and also weakened in the drive. WARRENSMYSTERYDICE settled off the leader and off the rail, raced four then five wide to the stretch and was outrun. LOVE GONE WEST unhurried early, lugged out around the turn and weakened.
