JUST CHARMED was bit antsy in the gate, forced the early issue, rushed up to grab the lead, cleared around the turn and proved best under steady handling. SLOKKIE broke out and bumped hard with outside rival, settled inside, stalked leaders, angled out bit in upper stretch and chased winner home. DANCER MAN bumped leaving the gate, chased off the rail then four wide around the turn and finished evenly. MIG ALLEY unhurried early, raced well off rail and outside foe, angled over around the bend, found the rail and improved placing. A STAR FOR US was pinballed hard from between horses leaving the gate, trailed early, saved ground to the stretch, came out some and was no factor. WHYA DA WHYA showed brief early speed then taken just off the leaders, prompted the pace while three wide, bumped with rival on the turn and weakened. MOSTRO MARINO was bumped hard from between horses in opening strides, recovered and sped to the front, overtaken into the turn, dropped back, taken off the rail while giving way, was eased in the stretch and walked off.
