Footnotes

POURIA sped clear of the field soon after the start, controlled the pace into and around the turn, then responded to mild urging and finished strong to the wire. FLEET IRON broke in and bumped foe at the start, chased the speed into the turn, traveled off the rail around the bend, then was asked entering the stretch but failed to make an impact on the winner while proving second best. MACHO MANDATE unhurried in the early stages, saved ground along the rail, then rallied and gained the show. DOWNTOWN KING allowed to settle after the start, raced near the rail and improved position in the stretch. TROUBLE AT SEA chased the winner into the turn, raced four wide on the bend, then weakened down the lane. SOUVENIR SUMMER was never a factor. MI MARINO bumped by outside foe, then stumbled and lost the rider at the start.
