DAILY SUDS broke out bit, settled outside, stalked pace while three wide, advanced four wide into the lane, reeled in leader under right hand urging and was along in time. EL GRAN BULL forced the early issue while three deep, continued on same path, reached the front in upper stretch, edged away but could not hold off the winner. LANE'S LUCK dueled outside rival to the turn, gained slim advantage around the bend, lost command in upper stretch and yielded approaching the finish. FALL APART was off bit slow, rushed up and angled in some, tracked the leaders from the inside but weakened some in the drive. CRIMINAL INTENTION broke out and bumped rival, settled inside, saved ground throughout but never menaced. SWEET SENOR contested the early pace from the inside, lost contact around the turn and weakened from the inside. WARRENS SKY WRITER bumped at the start, reserved off the pace, chased three wide the outside foe and lacked needed rally. RAPID ROBERT was bumped and jostled from between foes at the start, chased four wide into the lane, came out further and was outrun. MINISTER'S PRAISE was forced out some at the start, lagged back, chased well off the fence throughout and was also outrun.
