ZOLAZANE pressed the pace while three deep, cleared foes around the bend, widened advantage into the lane, then held safely in the drive. PLANET JANET broke out and bumped foe at the start, chased the speed from off the rail around the bend, then closed well in the stretch. CUVEE BLUSH vied for command from along the inside, then weakened in the late stages. SEATTLEINSPIRATION bumped start, tracked just off the pace, then failed to rally when asked. PARIS CAR SHOW showed no early speed, saved ground along the rail and was never a factor. R. C. STORM showed early speed and vied between rivals for command, then steadied nearing the quarter pole and faded after.
