Footnotes

SMOKIN MOJO allowed to settle into position toward the back of the pack, ran up the heels of rival and angled in around the bend, then surged in the lane and cleared late. WARREN'S DASHER tracked the leader into the turn from along the inside, continued along the rail into the stretch, then finished willingly for the place. KEITH THE MAILMAN raced near the back of the field early on, raced two wide into the turn, angled in on the bend, then finished well in the drive. TUMBLING DICE MAN raced near the middle of the pack early on, took the turn four wide, then finished evenly in the stretch. FREE BET bumped start, sped to the front and set the pace, continued clear while racing in the two path, then weakened in the lane. GETAWAY PANCHO chased the speed into the turn, traveled off the rail into the stretch, faded out of contention, then shifted in mid-stretch and impeded foe. ETHIOPIAN dropped to the back of the field early on, saved ground around the bend, then was force to check by rival who shifted in mid-stretch. FLASHY EYES broke in and bumped rival at the start, raced five wide into the lane and was never a factor. The stewards disqualified GETAWAY PANCHO from sixth to seventh for shifting in and impeding ETHIOPIAN mid-way through the stretch.
