Footnotes

BANK ROBBER broke out and bumped foe at the start, sped clear of the field, padded lead into the turn, raced well clear into the lane, weakened late but held safely. ONE FOR NOTHING tracked the leader early, raced outside a rival on the backstretch, angled in and raced along the rail to the stretch, then showed a mild rally to whittle the gap on the winner. FISCAL CLIFF chased the pace from the two path into and around the bend, was within striking distance at the top of the lane but lacked the late kick. FIND THE ANSWER knocked into rival leaving the gate, saved ground near the rail and improved position in the stretch. BLINDED BY FAME also knocked into rival at the start, was unhurried down the backstretch, went two wide around the turn and failed to rally. RIO VALLEY bothered at the start, went three wide into the lane and proved no menace. CUATRERO bumped by inside rival at the start, showed no speed early on, traveled in the two path on the turn and failed to threaten.
