### Footnotes

RAISIN' CAIN chased early, moved up and vied for the lead from the inside, dueled in the upper stretch and drew clear late. SWEET JUJU sped clear from the start, vied between rivals into and around the bend, then flattened in the late stages. WARREN'S PASSION tracked the pace four wide down the backstretch, angled in and raced two wide into the lane, then finished evenly late. ELLA BEA AWESOME unhurried in the early going, took the turn two wide and failed to rally. PARA ANGEL chased the speed, vied three deep into and around the bend, then gave way in the stretch. SMART SUZZET saved ground while off the pace and weakened in the stretch.
