RANDOM LUCK was bumped from between rivals at the start, settled early while taken to the rail, advanced inside, reached the front past sixteenth marker then edged away. GOLDEN MIRACLE broke in and bumped rival, settled off the rail, chased three wide, came out further in the stretch and got up late for second. TO THE TOP emerged from outside with the lead, angled over then padded cushion around the turn, came two wide into the stretch, grew weary then lugged out and lost second in final yards. ERMINE'S PRAYER broke out and bumped rival, unhurried while bit off the rail, remained bit wide and lacked needed response. SPOONEX gained stalking position while outside eventual winner, remained off the rail and weakened. DANCING KITTY bobbled in opening strides, briefly duelled from between rivals then tracked the leaders while outside foe, dropped back on the turn, then gave way readily in the stretch, was eased but did cross the finish line and was walked off.,
