### Footnotes

CATQUEST settled off the pace and along the inside, angled out entering the stretch, surged late and powered away under hand urging. MARK'S CAT set the pace without pressure, raced near the inside through the turn, continued clear into the lane but was no match late. CUT TO THE FRONT threw head and was off slow to begin, trailed the field early, went four wide while advancing on the turn, then showed a good late effort to gain the show. LUCKY TO YOU chased the speed from off the rail into the stretch and weakened. GENERAL BEE LUCKY chased the speed down the backstretch, raced between rivals, steadied into the turn, lost ground around the bend and weakened in the stretch. VALLEY SPIRIT raced along the inside, two wide into the lane and was never a factor. FLASHY PLAYER raced towards the back of the field, went four wide on the turn and failed to threaten.
