ABSOLUTELY UNREAL was hustled away three wide into the turn, shook free of PRESS PLAY on the turn to take control, then began to tire a bit in deep stretch and was kept to a steady drive in order to hold sway. RIO HOPE veered out after the break, bumping into FALLEN FOR FREEDOM, then began to bear out badly on the turn, losing considerable ground, but came on strong once straightened to nab the place money on the wire. DONSGAL made a bid from a bit off the rail to gain second late on the turn only to be nabbed for the position in the final strides. FALLEN FOR FREEDOM got knocked into THE PRINCESS HOUSE by RIO HOPE soon after the break but made a mild bid inside down the lane. PRESS PLAY forced the winner's hand early from near the rail but steadied back slightly at the quarter, drifted out and tired. IN IT TO WIN IT was through early racing three wide. THE PRINCESS HOUSE got bumped early on and was always outrun.
