SUMALEE was hard asked to grab early lead, controlled the pace from off the rail, edged away and safely held. TABLE FOR ONE awaited room from the inside early on the turn, angled out some, rallied two wide and was along for second. MI GATITA stalked from between horses, continued three wide into the stretch and was outfinished for second. ZCAT'S QUIET STORM dueled then forced the pace from the inside, later dropped back and weakened. THUNDER FOOT chased from the far outside, caught five wide into the turn, later came in some but was no threat. MISS SEAMLESS stalked from between rivals, came in slightly nearing quarter marker and weakened. OUTBACK MELISSA unhurried from the inside, angled out some, was forced out further early on the turn and never recovered. SALLY'S BLADE stalked from between horses, clipped heels of MISS SEAMLESS nearing the quarter marker and then lost its rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the incident at the quarter marker and disqualified MISS SEAMLESS for coming in and causing SALLY'S BLADE to clip heels.
