**Footnotes**

STORMY INFERNO battled outside rival into bend, gained command midway on the turn, padded that margin while slightly off the rail and had plenty left to hold off runner-up. DIXIE HAWKS settled outside rival, chased two wide into the stretch, came out some, rallied strongly and whittled gap on winner. BLOOM TIME tracked leaders from the inside, was in bit tight along the rail leaving the backstretch, dropped back some, came out, re-rallied from between horses and gained third. CRUZ'N KITTY stumbled badly in opening strides, angled out, chased three wide to the stretch and finished with interest from between foes. FIRE AND SPICE contested the pace from inside winner, dropped back bit leaving the turn, remained along the fence and lost placing late. CONDITIONER stalked leaders from the outside, continued three then four wide into the lane and weakened. SWEET AND JAZZY settled while bit off the fence, chased two wide, shifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly from the far outside.
