Footnotes

LOCKSMITH engaged in speed duel from the inside into and through most of the turn, gained slim advantage exiting the bend, kicked clear and safely held under urging. SOUVENIR SUMMER was off bit slow and lightly bumped by inside rival, advanced inside around the turn, remained along the fence and finished strongly inside winner. WETASKIWIN bobbed slightly leaving the gate, chased on three wide path, continued off the rail into the stretch, angled over under strong asking in the lane and was up late for third. KENTER CANYON hooked up in prolonged duel outside winner, lost contact in upper stretch, weakened and was overtaken late for third. BOBBY THE FAT BOY came out slightly and bumped outside foe at the start, chased inside throughout and never reached contention. WARRENS SKY WRITER tracked leading duo into the turn, continued two then three wide, was between horses leaving the turn and weakened in final eighth.
