**Footnotes**

SHADY VOTES broke out bit, content to stalk pacesetter early, moved up quickly and surged past leader, drew off around the turn and scored convincingly under light hand pressure late. LAST CHANCE BOBBY settled off the pace, tracked leaders on three wide path, remained off the rail into the stretch, drifted out under left hand urging, was straighten and finished willingly. SIBERIAN RUBLE rushed up inside to grab lead, set pace into the bend, had little resistance for the winner then weakened from the inside. TAYLOR MARINI unhurried leaving the backstretch chute, angled over nearing the turn, remained inside and never threatened. MAR SAL was fractious in the gate, chased from the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out some but was outrun. STAMPS SECRET SAUC reserved early, outside rival chasing the pace, remained bit off the rail and was outrun throughout.
