Footnotes

TRICKY SPEED dueled briefly outside rival then set pressured pace into turn, edged away around the bend, secured the rail and powered away under steady handling. UNUSUALLY BRITE between horses early then stalked the pace on two wide path, between rivals again in the drive and gamely gained second. COCINA was off a step slow, chased three wide then outside runner-up around the turn and was outfinished by that foe for the place. SWISS SPIRIT was bit antsy in the gate but broke alertly, contested then forced the pace from the inside, lost contact on the turn and weakened in the drive. TRACK MAJESTY settled off the pace and off the rail, chased three wide, was fanned four wide around the turn, came back in some but never menaced. NITRO LADY came out some leaving the chute, angled back inside, saved ground thereafter but was outrun. BLUE MOON DANCER chased from slightly off the fence, lugged out around the turn and never recovered.
