MIDNIGHT EXCESS was off alertly and quickly stepped to front, gradually crossed over, controlled all the pace from the inside and lasted. SLOKKIE broke out bit and bumped foe, stalked three wide, continued on same path into the stretch, chopped gap on winner late and just ran out of ground. ALPINE NUGGET came in bit while settling off the pace, advanced some around the turn, remained on three wide path and finished with interest. SCOTTY'S LADD close up early from the inside, dropped back bit, drifted out around the turn but improved placing late. TALK OF A CAT bumped from between horses at the start, reserved well off the rail, chased four wide around the turn and was no threat. NATIONWIDE FAMILY forced the early pace inside, lost contact into and around the bend and weakened. BUSBY settled off the pace, chased three wide, was fanned out around the turn, came four wide into the lane and failed to menace. SILVER HELMET bumped leaving the gate, outside rival early then four wide into the turn, angled in some but was outrun.
