**Footnotes**

BRIDGE TOO FAR reserved run early on, took the turn two wide, then produced a late surge and overhauled foe in the late stages. SHEZA MANEATER threw head and broke in to bump rival at the start, was unhurried in the early going, took the two wide, then rallied late and got up for the place. RIVER'S CHAPEL showed keen early foot and took control of the rail, padded lead around the bend, then weakened late but held on for second. SMOKIN MOJO bumped at the start, angled in on the backstretch, raced two wide into the lane, then finished willingly. PLEASURE GROUNDS allowed to settle down the backstretch, drifted out around the bend and proved no menace. MARSHAL LUCKY chased the speed while angling over to race near the rail, then weakened late.
