RED RAJ was never far back, moved between rivals nearing the sixteenth pole and was up late. LEEPER broke sharply to duel for the lead from off the rail, drifted out nearing the sixteenth marker and just missed. APPLICATOR dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way in the late stages. EL BOLLIYO raced just off the leaders early, moved outside for the drive and showed some late run. FINDERS KEY was bumped at the start, raced between foes into the lane and lacked the needed closing response. BEAUTIFUL STORY saved ground throughout and failed to gain late. I'LL PLAY HIGH was bumped at the start, raced wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. INDEPENDENT lacked early foot, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace.
