**Footnotes**

FRIENDLY HALF chased the speed into the turn, bid entering the stretch from the outside, then cleared foe and drew away under a drive. SWISS ALPINE sped to the front and gained a clear advantage, angled in and took control of the rail, continued to lead into the stretch but weakened late and held the place. SAFEONTHEWIRE allowed to settle in the early going, took the turn two wide, then closed well down the lane but missed the place. PHIL THE USHER chased the speed down the backstretch, traveled along the inside around the turn and into the stretch, then finished evenly late. KALOOKAN HEAT showed no early speed, went three wide around the bend and proved no menace. TIPPETARIUS raced along the inside into the turn, then two wide around the bend and was never a factor.
