Footnotes

HOVIG set a pressured pace down the backstretch, cleared foe around the turn and took control of the rail, then drew off in the stretch. LOCKSMITH pressed the pace from along the inside into the turn, lost touch with the leader around the bend and traveled two wide into the stretch, then failed to find the needed late kick but held the place. SOUVENIR SUMMER settled off the pace, angled in to race along the inside, advance near the rail through the turn, then finished evenly and held the show. WETASKIWIN chased the early speed down the backstretch, took the turn four wide, then went willingly late and missed the show. RICKY EL CORREDOR raced near the back of the field, saved ground along the rail, then improved position in the stretch. HECOULDGOALLTHEWAY chased just behind the pace into the turn, raced five wide into the lane and failed to rally when asked. MALIBU'S REFRAIN showed no early speed, was located off the rail around the bend and proved no menace. SMOKIN MOJO traveled two wide and was never a factor.
