Footnotes

DOWNTOWN BANKER quickly stepped to the front, dictated all the pace from slightly off the rail and safely held under steady handling. PRECAPER gained stalking position while outside foe, remained two wide then between horses exiting the turn, roused in the drive and went willingly to the wire. DOUBLE POP unhurried while well off the fence, chased three wide, swung out five wide entering the stretch, rallied on far outside and was along for third. MIG ALLEY was off bit slow, rushed up inside, tracked pacesetter from the inside and along the rail around the turn and in the lane but lost the show late. MEDIA MAKER widest of all early chasing the pace, caught three wide on the turn then four wide into the lane and was no threat. I'M UNFAITHFUL settled while slightly off the rail, chased on two wide path to the stretch and lacked needed late punch. JUST CHARMED angled over and pressed the pacesetter into the bend, dropped back then weakened from between horses. SILIC'S KID unhurried while crossing over, continued inside thereafter and was outrun.
