RIVER'S CHAPEL contested the early issue while outside rival, gained command then edged away into the stretch, continued on same two wide path and held under urging. WARREN'S HOT STUFF stalked from off the rail then three wide, remained on same path and whittled gap on winner late. CAPTAIN SHAWN D dueled from along the rail and inside winner, dropped back some around the turn, remained along the fence and bested others. FALL APART bumped at the start, tracked the pace while two then three wide, came out further in upper stretch and finished well from the outside. CRISTALANO stalked from the inside, continued on two wide path and finished evenly. RAYMANJJOHNSONJR broke out and bumped rival at the start, unhurried early, saved ground and lacked needed rally. OUR JUKE BOX HERO bumped from between rivals at the break, reserved from well off the rail early, later chased from outside foe and never menaced. SEVEN BELOW was off slow, chased from the inside, also saved ground but was outrun throughout.
