**Footnotes**

CHIEF'S LAKE three deep early then forced early issue outside rival, joined that foe on the turn, battled into the lane, inched away and held under urging. PREAMCH THE GOSPEL stepped to the front, set pace from the inside, resisted when challenged on the turn, could not match winner in the drive but gamely held second. PRIMARY NOTICE settled outside, advanced some then angled over, moved up along the rail, loomed passing sixteenth marker and missed the place. TAXI FLEET settled inside, chased along the rail, was in bit tight entering the turn, came off the fence and finished willingly. FOR CONTRAST prominent early from between foes, came in some, later found the rail but weakened. DARK MATTER dropped back early, trailed and was eventually eased in the stretch then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR threw his head in a very awkward start then was pulled up shortly after the break and walked off. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the start but ruled that TURNAGAIN TAYLOR cause his own problem.
