Footnotes

AMERICAN EXCESS sped to the lead soon after the start, cleared foes entering the turn, took control of the rail around the bend, then drew off down the lane. MR TOKYO tracked off the pace, steadied nearing the quarter pole, raced wide into the stretch, then showed a late rally to gain the place. CUSTOM CONTINENTAL raced near the back of the back early on, saved ground along the inside, then rallied along the rail to get up for third. INDIAN GAMING stumbled leaving the gate, chased the speed from along the inside, drifted out around the turn, then failed to show a response when needed. BILL MAKER failed to show early speed, traveled off the rail into the lane and never threatened. BEST BE GONE chased the winner while two wide down the backstretch, drifted out on the bend, then faded in the stretch. SWISS GUARD stumbled badly and lost the rider at the start.
