Footnotes

TIKOLINO tracked just off the pace, drifted out into the stretch, closed well and drew away. CHARM ME chased down the backstretch, bid around the turn from the outside, gained the lead entering the stretch, then was no match late for the winner. SINGLE WING bumped start, set the early pace while gaining control of the rail, then weakened in the stretch. WORLD CELEBRITY settled off the pace, angled in to find the rail around the turn, then finished evenly late. CHICKS RULE raced near the middle of the field, angled in and saved ground, then finished evenly late. STAGE STAR BARBIE broke thru gate, showed no early speed, took the turn two to three wide, and was a factor. SCREEN QUEEN stumbled, bumped, and checked off the heels of rival at the start, and failed to recover after. A SONG AT TWILIGHT bumped start, raced near the back of the pack, angled in to save ground but was never a factor.
