Footnotes

WARREN'S HOT STUFF pressed the pace from along the inside, moved up to duel with BIG CITY SLICKER around the turn, then kicked clear in the stretch and was under mild urging to the wire. DAILY SUDS tracked just off the speed duel, took the turn three wide, altered out mid-stretch, then gained the place. BIG CITY SLICKER away quickly and set a pressured pace, dueled with rival from the outside around the bend, then tired in the stretch. SKY CHIP settled off the pace, went four wide into the stretch and failed to respond when asked. RUNNING BEAR showed no early speed, raced in the two path around the bend and passed tired foes. WHO DARE raced near the middle of the field early on, traveled a bit off the rail into the stretch and failed to threaten. GOODLOOKINDUDE failed to match strides early, traveled five wide on the turn and was never a factor
