Footnotes

DIXIE HAWKS broke inward and bumped rival, secured the inside early, moved up and tracked leaders into the turn, shifted out in upper stretch, surged past pacesetter and cleared under urging. SALLY'S BLADE bumped by winner leaving the gate, chased early from the inside, came off the rail, shifted out further and came four wide into the stretch and reeled in rival late to grab second. NO APOLOGY was sent up inside to gain command, set pace and padded lead on the turn, was overtaken in the drive then lost second in final yards. LUCK BE A LILY prompted the pace from the outside, continued three wide, caught three abreast exiting the turn and finished evenly. STICK N STAY forced the early pace from between horses, continued on two wide path, lost contact around the turn and weakened. GOLDEN MENTOR lagged back early then was steered to the rail, remained inside and lacked needed response. UNUSUALLY BRITE reserved while well off the fence, chased three then two wide to the stretch, came back out some in the lane but was outrun.
