Footnotes

CITY LIGHTS close up earlier from off the rail, moved up and bid outside pacesetter entering the lane, reached the front in mid stretch, edged away and lasted. SUTTER BUTTE stalked pace from the inside, continued along the rail, rallied strongly in the final sixteenth and narrowly missed. WHATEVER WHENEVER quickly stepped to the front, set pressured pace while bit off the rail, resisted when challenged into the lane but was outfinished. ROB'S AFLEET forced the early issue from between foes, lost contact on the turn, shifted out into the lane and bested others. UTAH BEACH reserved from well off the rail, chased four wide into and around the bend and never threatened. ALIE'S DIN DIN lagged well back from along the rail, remained inside, steadied sharply in upper stretch and was no factor. ON THE BILL DAILY stumbled badly leaving the gate, prompted the early pace from the outside, dropped back then angled in and faded. SORCERERS SPELL threw his head and hesitated to be off far behind the field then trailed far back throughout.
