HEAVENLY BEING dueled into and on the turn from the inside, gained lead then edged away while drifting out in upper stretch, resisted when challenged later in the drive and stubbornly held while coming out further in late stages. WARRENSMYSTERYDICE settled off the pace then chased while outside rival then between horses, advanced around the bend, loomed inside leader in the lane, fought gamely to the wire but was denied. SURROUND gained stalking position from off the rail, closed gap on leaders on the turn, loomed outside and four wide entering the lane, came out further and went willingly to the finish from the outside. JOYFUL CREATOR unhurried early, raced from off the rail, continued three wide on the turn and into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. OUR LITTLE KITTY settled inside, remained along the rail throughout and lacked needed response. BLACK WILDCAT contested the pace from outside winner, lost contact in upper stretch and gave way in final sixteenth. TABLE FOR ONE stumbled badly in opening strides and unseated its rider, Following a stewards inquiry involving the start, it was ruled at TABLE FOR ONE caused its own problem.
