Footnotes

SOCK IT TO 'EM dueled early from the inside, inherited clear lead on the turn, lugged out under left hand urging in mid stretch but was straightened and safely held. MANDATE HABIT stalked pace from between foes, remained on same path into the stretch and edged away late for the place. TIPPETARIUS bumped with inside foe at the start, tracked leaders from the inside, remained along the rail and was outfinished for second. STRONG BELIEF caught three abreast into the turn, chased four wide exiting the bend and finished evenly. SHERRY'S REDDY broke out and bumped foe, reserved off the pace, chased from the inside, came out entering the stretch and lacked needed rally. SEISMOMETER was washy going to the gate, lagged back, was taken to the rail, raced inside thereafter and was no factor. REITERATE contested the early issue from between foes, lugged out badly around the turn, came six wide into the stretch and never recovered. NO CAPS NO FLOORS forced the early pace from the outside, was fanned out around the turn, forced seven wide into the stretch, came in some later but also never recovered.
