Footnotes

MINISTER MACHINE pressured the early pacesetters, moved up to challenge on the turn, gained control approaching the stretch, continued off the rail and powered away under steady handling. INDIAN GAMING contested the early pace while outside rival, briefly battled inside winner on the turn, could not go with that foe, remained inside and safely held second. SHADY VOTES dueled early from along the rail, dropped back around the turn, remained inside and gamely held the show. SIBERIAN RUBLE chased from the inside into the bend, veered out sharply to avoid fallen rider on the turn and finished evenly. WARREN'S BANDIT settled off the leaders while gradually angling over, raced two wide into the turn, also shifted out suddenly to avoid the accident on the turn, came four wide into the lane and was no threat. MR. VALENTINO was outrun early, trailed while slightly off the fence, saved ground throughout and never menaced. AT LAST A WILDCAT reserved from well off the rail, chased while outside rival, was also forced out midway on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and never recovered. MR TOKYO gained stalking position while bit off the fence, continued close up into the bend, took bad step nearing three-sixteenths marker and unseated its rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the incident on the turn and ruled that MR TOKYO was racing in the clear when he broke down.
