Footnotes

TOPLESS quickly stepped to the front, set uncontested pace from slightly off the fence, retained cushion into the lane and safely held under steady handling. PAY FOR PLAY settled outside, stalked four wide then whittled gap on leader around the turn, loomed in upper stretch and went willingly to the wire while outside winner. MORNING FROST settled off the pace and outside foe, chased between rivals then four wide into the stretch and gamely gained third from between foes. GOLDEN GAB settled outside, raced four wide to the turn, came out further leaving the bend and was outfinished for third from well off the rail. HEAVENLY BEING stalked from slightly off the fence, continued two wide to the stretch, came out some and failed to menace. HARD EIGHT reserved off the pace, was in bit tight then shuffled back nearing the turn, angled over, continued inside thereafter and lacked late bid. DIXIE HAWKS was off step slow, lagged back early, chased from between horses then three wide into the lane and lugged out in late stages. HEY TEACH showed brief early foot, stalked from between horses, dropped back around the turn and weakened. SHANDAHIA reserved from along the rail, saved ground but was outrun throughout.
