Footnotes

GOLD N THE ROAD drifted in leaving the chute, tucked in behind dueling leaders, continued on two wide path into the lane, roused then whittled gap on leader and nailed that rival in final yards. FAST TRACKING was hustled to the front, set pressured pace from the inside, shook free in upper stretch, dug in from along the rail but was caught nearing the wire. WHO U FOOLIN between horses early, remained on four wide path into and around the turn, rallied from the outside and cleared for the show. I WILL RISE pressured the pacesetter into the turn, remained outside that foe, drifted out bit into the lane, lost contact and yielded in the drive. K TARIB caught widest of all to the turn, caught five wide around the turn then lugged out further in the stretch and lacked any response. HOT CINDER was off bit slow, came off the fence early, chased three wide, came in slightly leaving the turn and lacked needed response. JACK OF PLUNDER lagged back early, angled over, chased from the inside then along the rail in the stretch while outrun. GOALIE prominently placed from between horses early, remained on three wide path to the stretch then weakened.
